OUSD(P) is the principal staff assistant and advisor to the Secretary of Defense and the Deputy Secretary of Defense for all matters concerning the formation of national security and defense policy. OUSD(P)'s mission is to consistently provide responsive, forward-thinking, and insightful policy advice and support to the Secretary of Defense, and the Department of Defense, in alignment with national security objectives. In order to support OUSD(P)'s mission, the Enterprise Information Services (EIS) Directorate provides IT services to support mission applications. A primary EIS goal is to ensure OUSD(P) users have reliable and state-of-the-art automation capability with an emphasis on customer service.

OUSD(P) offices consists of the Assistant Secretary of Defense- International Security Affairs, Assistant Secretary of Defense-Global Strategic Affairs, Assistant Secretary of Defense-Homeland Defense and Americas Security Affairs, Assistant Secretary of Defense-Special Operations/Low-Intensity Conflict & Interdependent Capabilities, Assistant Secretary of Defense-Asian & Pacific Security Affairs, Deputy Under Secretary of Defense Strategy, Plans, & Forces, and Deputy Under Secretary of Defense Policy Integrations & Chief of Staff to include 3 field activity (Defense Prisoner of War/Missing Personnel Office (DPMO), Defense Security Cooperation Agency, Defense Technology Security Administration (DTSA)) offices. OUSD(P) has approximately 1,000+/- users, 8,000+ IT assets, and 75+/- offices within the Pentagon and National Capital Region to support its mission.
